

3rd Nordic EPOS Meeting, 26-27 September 2018

The 3rd Nordic EPOS meeting will be held at NORSAR's premises in Kjeller in the time period 26-27 September 2018. The meeting will commence at lunchtime on Wednesday 26 September and last until lunch on Thursday 27 September.

The European Plate Observing System, EPOS, is a long-term plan to facilitate integrated use of data, data products, and facilities from distributed research infrastructures for solid Earth science in Europe.

The goal of the Nordic EPOS meeting is to develop the Nordic EPOS dimension by finding Nordic collaboration forms in EPOS TCS and governance work and to discuss the practicalities, advances and the work done within the EPOS framework. The Nordic EPOS meeting is open to participants from all the fields represented in EPOS. To further promote the aspect of Nordic co-operation and collaboration, the meeting is arranged back-to-back with the 49th Nordic Seismology Seminar.

The meeting's programme will consist of sessions focusing in various aspects of EPOS from the Nordic perspective. We welcome both oral and poster presentations.
